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RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED BY 9th BOARD OF STUDIES IN PHYSICS

Department : Physics

Subject: Electronics

The Board of studies of Physics Department met on 20.08.2024 and unanimously resolved the following:

Resolved

- 1) To continue implementation of the Autonomous Education system in Single Subject Major system with 4 years B.Sc., Honors program as suggested by APCHE, Mangalagiri for students admitted from 2024-25 batch on words in English Medium.
- 2) To implement the guidelines of the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, A.P., Mangalagiri
- 3) To approve the syllabus, Model Question Papers and Blue Prints for first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, Eighth semesters of B.Sc., Degree course in Physics subject for both Major and Minor Streams from the Academic Year 2024-25 onwards. The fourth year curriculum is applicable to students admitted in fourth year from this academic year (2024-25) onwards
- 4) To approve Syllabus, Model Question Paper and Blue Print for Multidisciplinary Courses, Value Added Certificate Courses/ Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses(Languages), Skill Enhancement Courses, Open Online Transdisciplinary Courses, Environmental Courses, IKS(with zero credits),
- 5) To approve the credits allotted and weakly workload proposed for the above syllabus. External evaluation is done for 60 marks and internal evaluation for 40 marks for major and minor subjects.
- 6) To award internal marks strictly according to the CIA method prescribed by CCE, AP.
- 7) To implement multiple entry/exit for the program i.e. award of Certificate/Diploma/ Degree/Honors Degree to the students who successfully complete First/Second/Third/Fourth Years of 4-year Honors Degree Program
- 8) To implement CSP of 180 Hours with 4 credits after the end of II semester, Short-Term Internship of 180 Hours with 4 credits after the end of IV semester and Semester Internship/Apprenticeship/Online Job Training with 12 credits in VI semester Internship to UG students as per the course Structure proposed by APSCHE and Approved by CCE
- 9) To conduct first mid-semester exam off line and second mid-semester exam by Online/Offline
- 10) To approve the conduct of seminars, workshops, symposia, field visits, quiz competitions etc.,
- 11) To improve the curriculum as per norms of NAAC.

- 12) To encourage the participation of students in community centric activities
- 13) To encourage students to get trained by JKC in Communication Skills, Life Skills etc.
- 14) To improve teacher participation in Research and extension activities
- 15) To encourage e-classes/virtual classes/MOOCs/ SWAYAM/ On-line courses etc.,
- 16) To make MANA TV lessons accessible to students on-line/off-line
- 17) To conduct remedial coaching of academically weak students and to conduct advanced tutorials for fast learners
- 18) To conduct bridge course for needy students depending on the situation
- 19) To Recommend additional textbooks and study material as per the suggestions of Board of Studies
