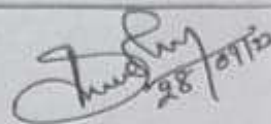
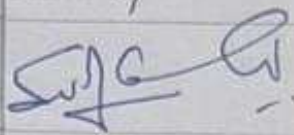
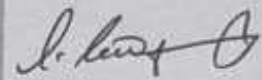
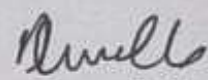
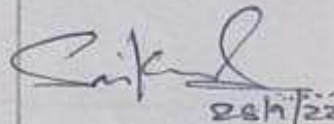
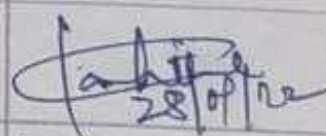
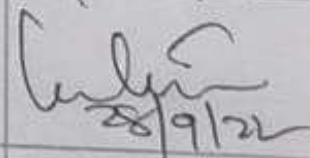
Minutes/Resolutions:

The Board of Studies of Department of English met on 28.09.2022 and resolved to

1. Implement the Autonomous Education System as per the staff Council's proceedings commencing from this academic year 2022-23 for the admitted batch of 1st year degree students of 2022-23.
2. Implement guidelines of the Academic Council.
3. Approve and ratify the syllabus for various Semesters under CBCS from 2022-23 academic years onwards.
4. Ratification of general english and special english syllabus for the academic year 2021-22.
5. Approve and ratify first and second year syllabus of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com/BBA logistics and first, second and third syllabus of special english for the admitted batch of 2022-23.
6. Approve and ratify Skill Development Courses (SDC) - Two courses 1. Journalistic Reporting (Arts Sem-II) 2. Disaster Management (Arts, Sem II). Life Skills Course (LSC) - Personality Enhancement and Leadership Skills (Sem. III).
7. Introduce Add-On-Course title "English Skills for Employment", for I & II-year students.
8. Conduct Seminars, Workshops and Students Centered Activities.
9. Adapt quality based Curriculum as per the norms of the NAAC.

10. Encourage students to join JKE/TESS/ELF programs to equip them with adequate skills sets in Communication and also to improve their personality development.
11. Encourage the student to participate in community centric activities like health programmes.
12. Implementation of classroom activities guided and graded on the basis of Blooms Taxonomy.
13. Setting up of question paper is also guided by the principles of Blooms Taxonomy (recall, understanding, application, analytical, evaluation and creative).
14. Implementations of Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and Evaluation for mid semester and semester end exams. The mid semester examination (IA) is assessed for 100 marks. (2 mid semesters of 50 marks each exam), and reduced/scale down to 25 marks and the external examinations is for 75 marks. The final total at the end of semester is 100 marks.
15. Approval and ratification of Question paper blue print, Model question paper and the system of Internal Assessment for Semester 1+04 (w.e.f 2022-23) admitted batch) for General English and semester 1+06 for Special English.
16. Encourage the students to undertake Community Service Project (CSP) for 1st years Internship for 2nd years and On Job Training for 3rd year students actively participate during their course of study.
17. Approval and ratify the list of Examiners for General English (English Praxis) and Special English).
