THE STATUS OF WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT IN SONIA GANDHI COLONY, THATICHETLAPALEM, VISAKHAPATNAM

INTRODUCTION:

Women's employment is directly connected with women's empowerment. According to the Organization of Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) mentioned in the Economic Survey 2017-18, "the proportion of women who work has steadily reduced over time, from 36 % to 24 % in a decade". According to National Family Health Survey(NHFS)-5 conducted from 2019-21, only 32% of girls and married women aged 15-49 are employed.(The Hindu, may 07, 2022) Even though women are in senior positions their number is very less when compared to their male counterparts. With much difficulty they are attaining senior positions within the organization's. In India, women's employment and their contribution to workforce is growing steadily but marginally.

Swaniti, a non-profit and non-partisan group quotes in its article *Status of Female Employment in India: Examining the Current Scenario* that the Survey Report notes, that women workers often constitute the most vulnerable of the workforce as they are "employed in the least secure, informal, unskilled jobs, engaged in low-productivity and low-paying work". The Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) 2020 reports that only 18.6% of working-age women in India participate in the labour force, three times lower than men.

PROFILE OF THE VILLAGE:

Sonia Gandhi Colony Area, Thatichetlapalem Mandal, is located in Visakhapatnam zonal municipality which comes under the Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation (GVMC), ward no.45 with the pin code 530016. The Area has a good transportation facility. It has a railway station within 1.5km distance and RTC complex within a distance of 3.0km, which are accessible for all the purposes. The population of the Area is approximately 55 thousand. They live in pucca buildings and using gas stove. All are sending their children to the school/collages for better education. The village is having the following facilities.

A)Municipal primary school

B)Anganwadi

C)Railway station

D) RTC Complex

A Community Survey Project was conducted in **51 houses** of this Area . In my Area many families depend on cultivation and small scale businesses. However, nearly 90% people are literates. The village follows the instructions of the government such as cleanliness and mainting open defecation free(ODF) Swachha Bharat. In the village nearly 95% are Hindus 4% are Christians and 1% are musilms and we boast of good communal harmony. All the school age children between 5 to 15 years age are going to school and there is no child labour in the village. In respect of

16 plus age group all girls are going colleges by means of bus/train/collage busses. No cases of child marriages are found.

Methodology:

The Community Survey Project was conducted by means of two methods.

1. Door to-Door Survey
2. Personal Interviews

FINDING OF THE SURVEY OBSERVATIONS:

The analysis of the Community Survey Project and Socio-economic survey conducted by me provides a general view of the reasons and hypotheses behind the low female employment.

- Out of 51 households surveyed by me 41 women are house wives and these women sometimes take part in cultivation.
- 7 women are employees in private firms. Recently some private firms like Daily work labourers, self employees, are established in RTC Complex and nearly 1kms away from the Area . 7 women are working in the above said companies in shift system. They reach the workplace by buses provided by the company authorities.
- High preference for a male child and low regard for a female child leads to inadequate nutrition, health and educational opportunities. Lack of health, sanitation and education opportunities are hindering the women employment.
- It is found that in many middle-class and poor families parents are not ready to provide or unable to provide equal educational opportunities for female children on par with their male siblings. It may be due to cultural and traditional issues, paternal mindset as well as economical conditions.

- Safety and security at the workplace, proper transportation facilities, and gender-biased salary/wages in private and unorganized sectors are also playing a key role in women's employment.
- A larger portion of women in rural areas/villages and tribal areas form the agricultural workforce. Many of them are self-employed or in an unorganized sector.
- Domestic chores and rearing of children are the two major responsibilities for women, a major hurdle for their employment opportunities.
- It is also observed in the survey that even though women are employed, most of them are not having economic freedom. Most of them are unable to spend their earnings to fulfil their minimum wishes. They have to hand over their salary to their father/mother-in-law/ husband or grown-up son/s.
- All the women belong to 40 households are not at all aware of Central Government Schemes like Mahila E-Haat, STEP (Support to Training and Employment Program For Women). They are only aware of Self-Help Groups Scheme of State Government.

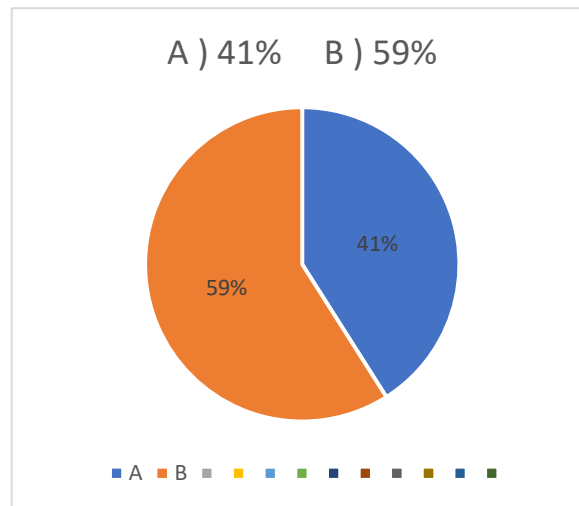

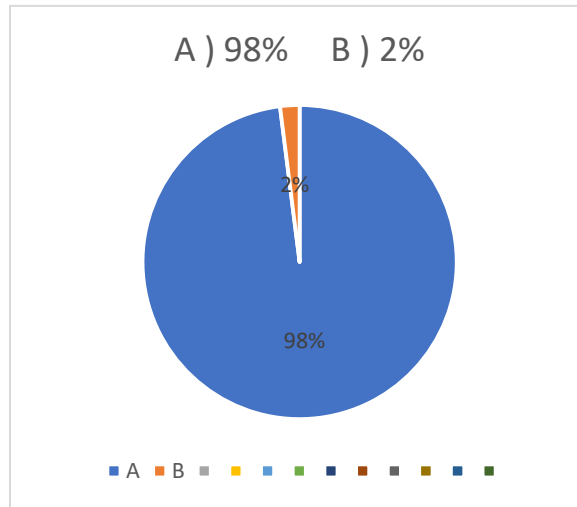

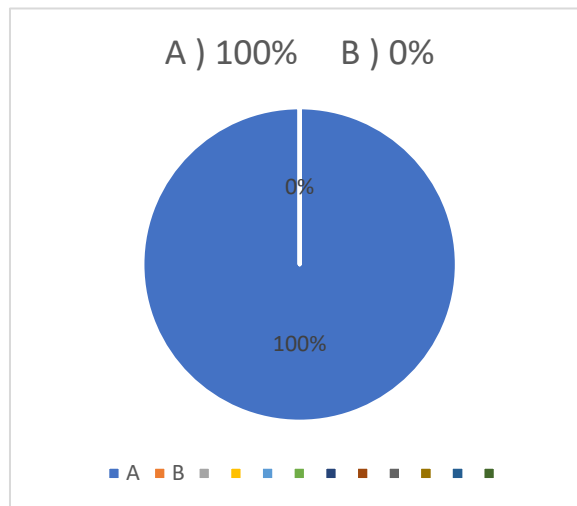

In spite of the various awareness programmes, encouragement and 33% reservations for women in educational institutions, government jobs and also in politics both at national and state level the country has not achieved major milestones in women's employment or entrepreneurship. In the same case with SONIA GANDHI COLONY The Status of Women's Employment in this village is only 22.72%. It is evident from the analysis that cultural, social issues play a key role in the increase of women's employment. It needs social transformation with regard to attitudes towards women.

SUGGESTIONS:

As working women percentage is low it is suggested that girls should get equal opportunity for higher education on par with boys. The patriarchal mind set of the society need to be changed so as to give financial and legal freedom to women. Family, friends, relatives and society should support women employees so that they can work without any social inhibitions. They should be given equal wages for equal work. Constitutional laws must be enforced to protect gender based violence against women at workplace
